Swami Vivekananda, Greatest Son of India

Modern society frequently discusses its strengths and shortcomings, yet in the 19th century, a young Bengali kid from a middle-class family in Kolkata who had spiritual views and a simple outlook on life attained a divine stature early in life. He declared that "Strength is Life and Weakness is Death." "Arise, awake, and do not stop until the goal is attained," he added. Can you already identify the boy? Yes, we are referring to Narendra Nath Dutta, who eventually attained the monastic title of Swami Vivekananda. A college student who, like other young males his age, enjoyed music and sports had a dramatic transformation.

Vivekananda, affectionately known as Swamiji, was born on January 12, 1863, as Narendranath Dutta in a wealthy Bengali family in British-ruled India. A well-known legal representative at the Calcutta High Court was his father, Vishwanath Dutta. In his many publications, Narendranath Dutta described his mother Bhuvaneshwari Devi as a goddess and described her as a "Divine Spirit" in his life.

Swami Vivekananda: The Inspiration to the Youth of India

He continued to serve as a source of inspiration for young people, and in honor of him, National Youth Day is observed on January 12th. Even now, we can still learn from his efforts the genuine purpose of the Bible and austerity. Krishna Bhakti? How can we forget that he founded the Ramakrishna Mission before calling his Guru Sri Ramakrishna Paramhansa in order to help the underprivileged members of society?

A man with in-depth knowledge of Vedas; Upanishads; Bhagavad Gita and much more used to believe that serving mankind is to serve God and hence he was the person who can say "God gave me nothing I wanted but He gave me everything I needed." Happiness to him was a smile on the face of the poor. He was inspired right from his childhood due to her mother's religious nature and father's rational mind who was a then Lawyer. We all are aware of his knowledge and personality, but most of us are unaware that Swamiji was a brilliant singer. He used to enchant devotional songs on his own to keep his mind at a peaceful stake. It is due to this ability he came across Ramakrishna Dev who happened to hear young Narendra Nath sing a devotional song that impressed Paramhansa. He then invited Vivekananda to Dakshineswar from where the life of Swamiji changed completely.

Near Ramakrishna, Swamiji's boyhood dream of seeing God in front of him came true. Swamiji formerly held a firm belief that, with the right support, people are born with the potential to do good for the country. The Brahma Samaj acknowledged the worship of a single God as an idol, which caught Swamiji off guard while he was a college student and sparked his curiosity about God. He acknowledged William Hastie, the former principal of Scottish Church College and the person who first introduced Swamiji to Ramakrishna, in one of his publications. Even in the twenty-first century, the saying, "You can lead if you win or else you will guide if you lose" holds true. We learned how to fight until the very end since the goal must be attained from Swamiji. His two most important teachings up till the end of his life were non-duality and selfless love. On July 4th, 1902, Swamiji passed away in Belur Math, West Bengal.

According to Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, "Education is the most important element for growth and prosperity of a Nation". He emphasized on skill-based education at the school level. According to him this is a significant reform that must be adopted in schools. In his speech at Delhi secretariat, he said & quote; when the students pass out of senior secondary schools, they should have two certificates of passing 10+2 examination and a specific skill acquired by him during schooling .& quote; Another facet of education is Spirituality. Spirituality is the one that Influence individuals' overall well-being and quality of life. Spirituality includes the recognition of a feeling or sense of belief. It helps in sustaining inner pace and fulfilment of any task by managing the stress. By attaining spirituality in student's, they become more capable to manage themselves with the challenges.

According to Swami Vivekananda, spirituality is the science of the soul and one can realize their own true nature. Spirituality helps to keep a good relationship with oneself, with others and environment. He believed & quote; Kinder Garden of spiritual life is service & quote; According to Dr APJ Abdul Kalam, spirituality is the way of doing good for the people and gives to lead a righteous life.

Therefore, Educational reformations and Spirituality are the two main important facets of education. From the observations and opinions of two educational thinkers Dr.A.P.J. Abdul Kalam and Swami Vivekananda, it may be concluded that inclusion of spirituality in curriculum will lead to a major educational reformation and thereby increasing the quality of education.
