

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

# Staff Corner



## *S.R. Ranganathan: Indian Library Pioneer*

S.R. Ranganathan (born August 9, 1892, Shiyali, Madras, India died September 27, 1972, Bangalore, Mysore) was an Indian librarian and educator who was considered the father of library science in India and whose contributions had worldwide influence.

Ranganathan was educated at the Hindu High School in Shiyali, at Madras Christian College (where he took B.A. and M.A. degrees in mathematics in 1913 and 1916), and at Teachers College, Saidapet. In 1917 he joined the faculty of Government College, Mangalore. He subsequently taught at Government College, Coimbatore, in 1920 and at Presidency College, University of Madras, in 1921–23. In 1924 he was appointed first librarian of the University of Madras, and in order to fit himself for the post he travelled to England to study at University College, London. He took up the job at Madras in earnest in 1925 and held it until 1944. From 1945 to 1947 he served as librarian and as professor of library science at Hindu University in Varanasi (Banaras), and from 1947 to 1954 he taught at the University of Delhi. During 1954–57 he was engaged in research and writing in Zürich. He returned to India in the latter year and served as visiting professor at Vikram University, Ujjain, until 1959. In 1962 he founded and became head of the Documentation Research and Training Centre in Bangalore, with which he remained associated for the rest of his life, and in 1965 he was honored by the Indian government with the title of national research professor in library science.

Ranganathan's chief technical contributions to library science were in classification and indexing theory. His Colon Classification (1933) introduced a system that is widely used in research libraries around the world and that has affected the evolution of such older systems as the Dewey Decimal Classification. Later he devised the technique of "chain indexing" for deriving subject-index entries. Other works of his included Classified Catalogue Code (1934), Prolegomena to Library Classification (1937), Theory of the Library Catalogue (1938), Elements of Library Classification (1945), Classification and International Documentation (1948), Classification and Communication (1951), and Headings and Canons (1955). His Five Laws of Library Science (1931) was widely accepted as a definitive statement of the ideal of library service. He also drafted plans for a national and several state library systems, founded and edited several journals, and was active in numerous professional associations.

He passed on 27th September 1972. In his 80 years of life, he contributed to the field of library service, science and profession, he organized a human movement whose aim and enthusiastic contribution towards the field is witnessed even today. He wrote sixty books and 2000 articles. He was and will always be remembered as a stalwart of the library science.

It is a fundamental component of achieving success, then it will not be wrong since without the lack of arrogance you cannot achieve the life long true success in all the aspects of life. But with leading generation modesty is decreasing. People of this generation are more of arrogant and less of modest. They do not know how to respect and be humble to any normal individual having normal humanarial behaviour.

Sharing my own experience of what I witnessed in this context. I was going back to home from college by rickshaw. Two girls sat in and when they got down, they were asking for barcode scanner to pay the fare but the rickshaw driver neither had the scanner nor a smart phone so he asked for cash instead. Both of the girls were not having cash and only some change of around 8 Rs. which was not sufficient as the total fare of them was Rs. 40 so, instead of being sorry for not having the money or finding some other way to pay it, they simply said the driver arrogantly that, "we've only got small change. You take it if you want, otherwise let it go, we don't have cash" and they left from there going their own ways. This is not just a single incident of two college going students who were arrogant and not thankful for the help they got from the driver for free but also a stark warning of the direction our generation is taking. We are steadily losing our human values. The reason for this vanity can be many including social media influences, normalisation of provocative behaviour, decreased emphasis on traditional values and norms, but the thing is that we are loosing modesty on a large extent.




## Abdul Kalam's Birth Anniversary


# Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's Mahaparinirvan Din


# Field visit-Parle Food Products






## Mathematics Day Celebration








# Educational trip
