1. Introduction

The SSR College of Education organized a *Cleanliness Drive* under the Health and Wellness Course (107-B) to promote hygiene, environmental responsibility, and community participation. The activity aimed to sensitize students and the local community about the importance of maintaining public cleanliness and the harmful effects of irresponsible waste disposal.

2. Objectives

1. To create awareness in society towards the cleanliness of public places.

3. To educate communities on the consequences of waste dumping and the need for responsible waste management.

3. Description of the Activity

The drive began at 9:30 am at the Gram Panchayat of Sayli. Students and staff gathered at the venue and received instructions regarding safety, task allocation, and cleaning procedures. Participants engaged in various activities such as:

- Sweeping streets and nearby public areas
- Collecting plastic waste, dry waste, and biodegradable waste separately
- Cleaning the surroundings of community buildings
- Spreading awareness among local residents about cleanliness norms
- Displaying placards promoting “Swachhata Abhiyan” messages

Throughout the activity, staff and volunteers ensured proper waste segregation and transportation to the designated disposal points.




4. Community Awareness
